Mall plan review set to continue

The Merrimack Planning Board will continue reviewing pieces of a proposed outlet mall plan tonight.

Consultants hired by the town will present their findings on blasting and water quality and will address outstanding environmental issues stemming from a plan by Chelsea Property Group. The developer wants to build 135 high-end shops west of Exit 10 on the F.E. Everett Turnpike.

At the meeting, public comment will be allowed, both for the night's discussion and for topics relating to the July 1 meeting, at which there was no opportunity for the public to speak because the meeting ran late.

The meeting will be held in the courtroom at 7 p.m.
